



Appeals and Disputes

The Company has the right to Appeal against any Certificate Decision made by AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd., for example a decision to Withdraw Certification or a failure to grant Initial or Re-Certification. The Company also has the right to Appeal against any Non-Conformances raised by the Audit Team during an Audit.

If the Company does not accept either the Certificate Decision of AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd., or the Audit Team findings, they shall refer to the Appeals and Complaints Information Section, provided within the AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. Audit Report, detailing the appropriate procedure for the submission of a formal Appeal.

Written notification of the intention to Appeal must be made and received by AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. within seven days of the Certificate Decision, or the issuance of the Audit Team's Report.

An Appeals Form shall be sent, by AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd, to the Company for completion and must be returned to AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd, including with it any supportive documentation/ information for consideration during the Appeals Procedure, within 14 days of receipt.

All Appeals shall be forwarded to AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. Accredited Office to investigate the documentary evidence and the causes of the Appeal. Should the Accredited Office reject the Appeal it shall be forwarded to the AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. CEO for review.

Should the CEO investigate the documentary evidence and reject the Appeal, the Appeals Committee, drawn from the independent members of the Impartiality Committee, shall investigate the documentary evidence and consider the Appeal. The Company shall be advised of the names of the Impartiality Committee Appeals Committee members who shall review the Appeal, and the Company has the right to dispute the members of the Appeals Committee by formal notification of their dispute. This dispute shall be reviewed by the Chair of the Impartiality Committee, or by the Vice-Chair if the Chair is a member of the Appeals Committee. The result of the Appeals Committee review shall be notified to the Company.

The decision of the Impartiality Committee shall be final and binding on both the Company and AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. Once the decision regarding an Appeal has been made, no counter-claim by either party in dispute can be made to amend or change this decision.

For all upheld Appeals, investigations shall be conducted to develop the necessary Corrective and Preventive actions and to assess the effectiveness of the Corrective and Preventive Actions. In instances where the Appeal has been successful and the Certificate issued or reinstated, no claim can be made against AHCS Conformity Assessment (Pvt.) Ltd. for reimbursement of costs or any other losses incurred. The Company shall not suffer any discriminatory actions as a result of their Appeal.
